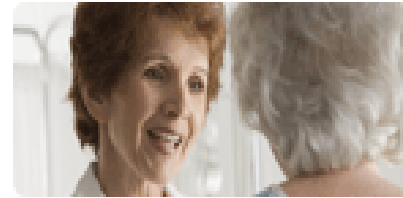

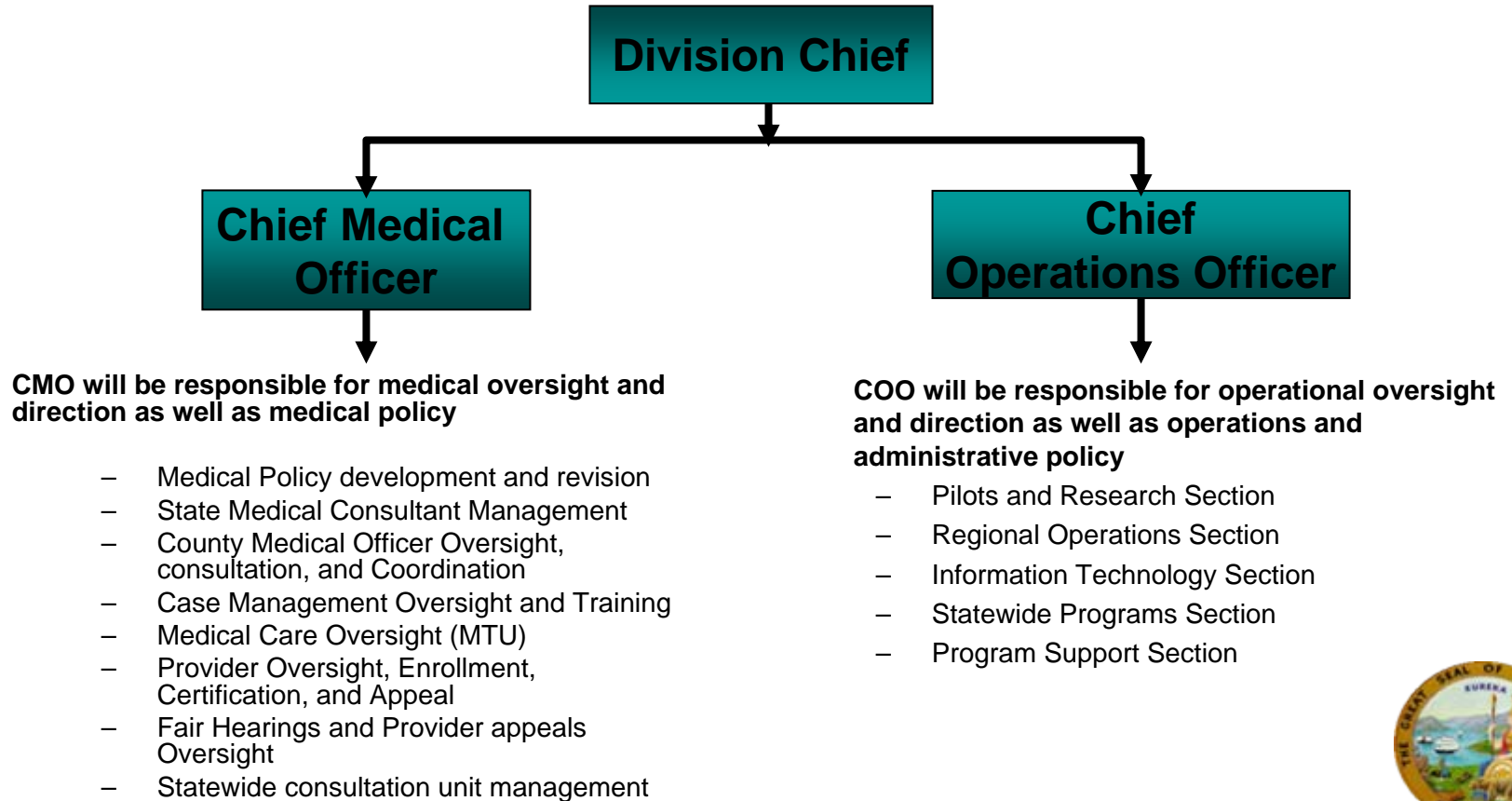


VISION for CMS

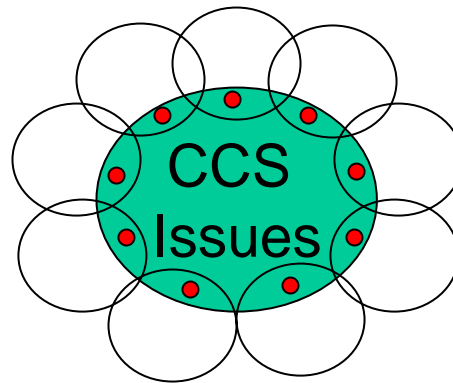


New Organizational Structure

Test innovative health care delivery models for transforming health care services for children with CCS conditions

Objective

Identify the model or models that will result in a well-integrated, coordinated and value-based health care delivery system





1115 Demonstration Waiver

- Transition Planning





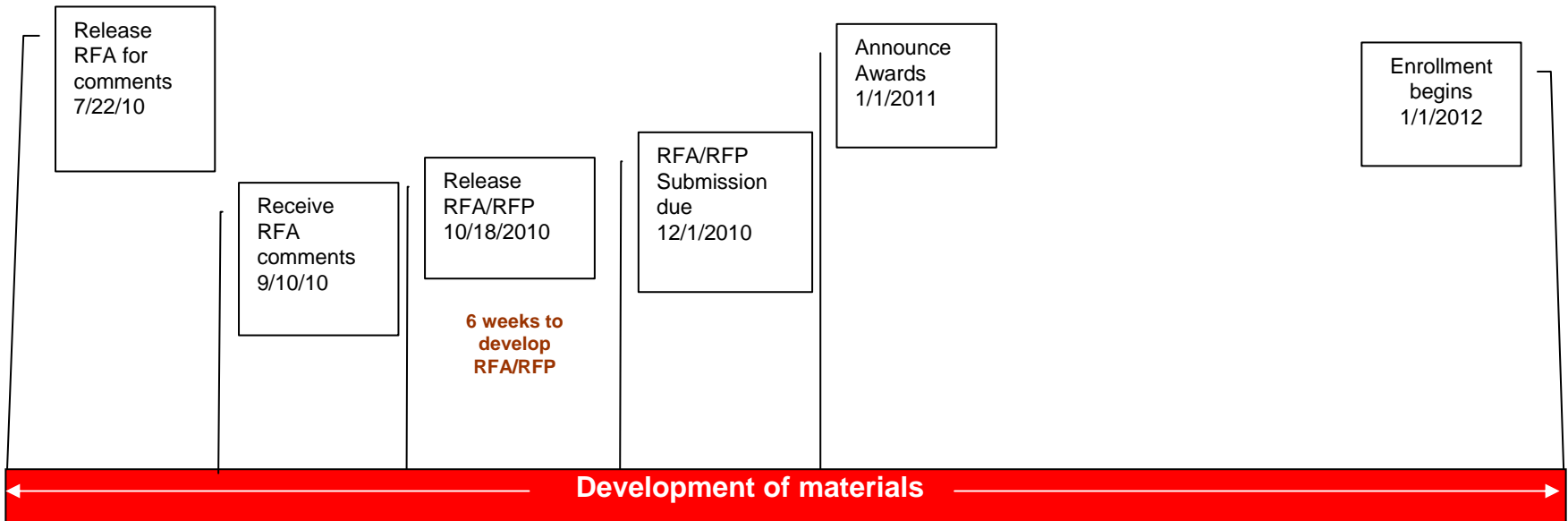
1115 Demonstration Waiver Four Models

(ACO)



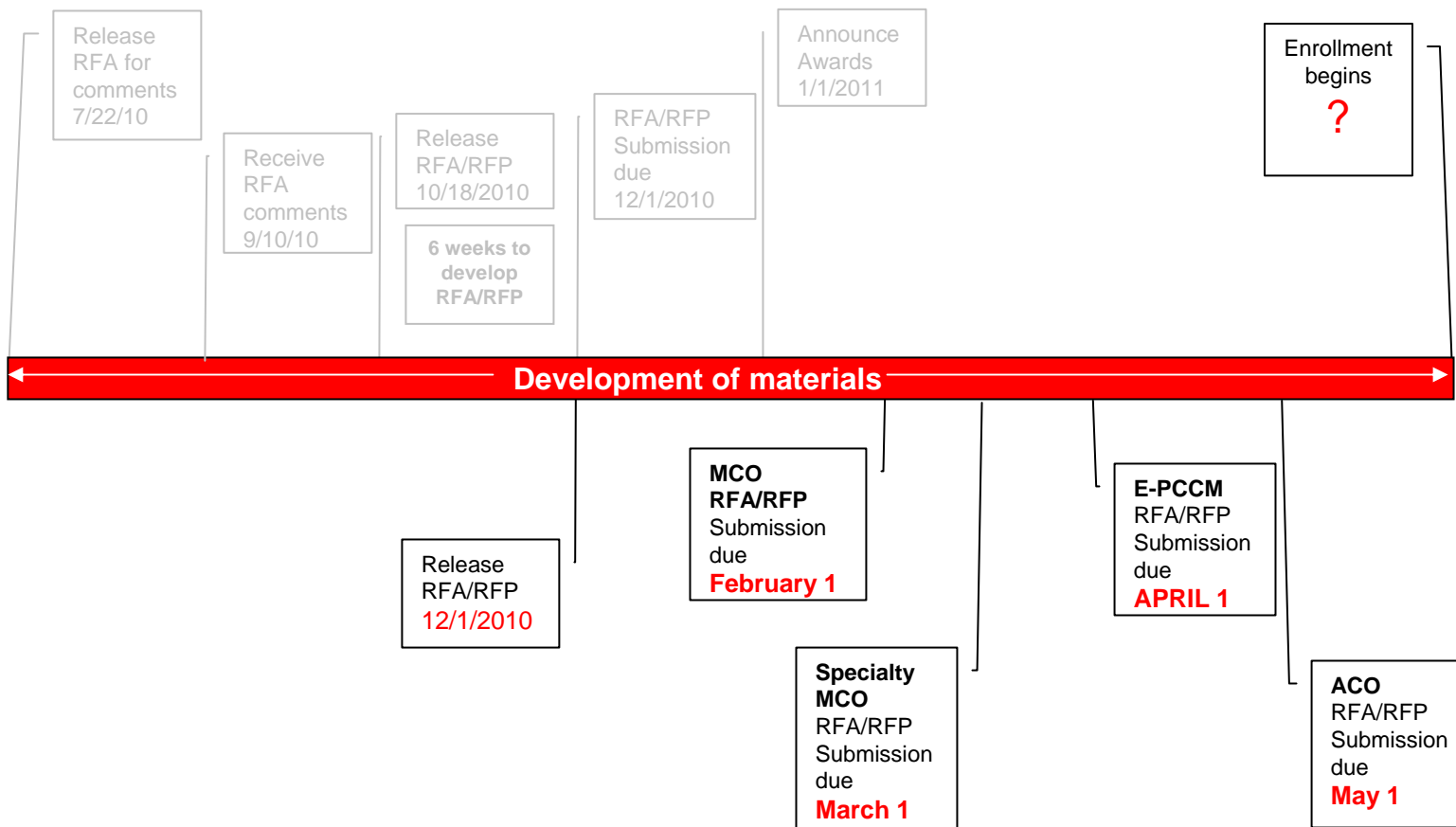
